- **Phone Only:** Dial *9 to “Raise Hand.” Staff will unmute you when it is your turn. If needed, dial *6 to toggle mute on/off. Once your public comment has ended, you will be muted again.
- If your phone is unmuted, and you are unable to be heard, the host may ask that you Dial *6 to toggle mute on/off in Zoom.
